Mort Walker: 8<sup>th</sup> "Cartoonist of the Year" (there are 60 of them now)

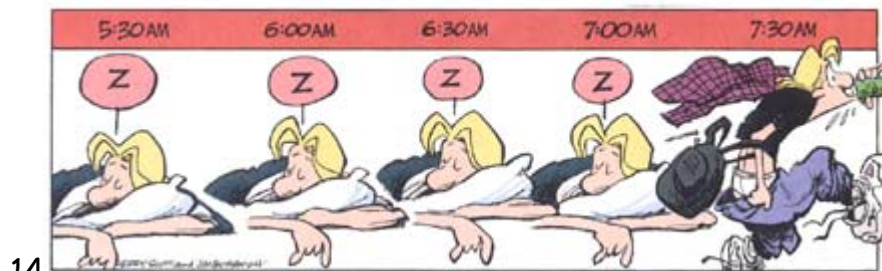
Jim Davis: founder of Paws, Inc. in 1981 (after 3 years of syndication)

Dik Browne: his son has actually written more: 18 vs. 15 years

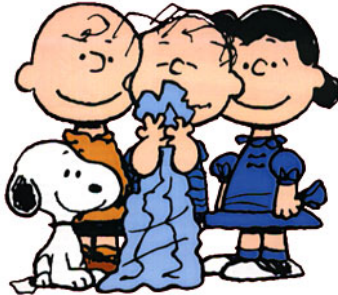

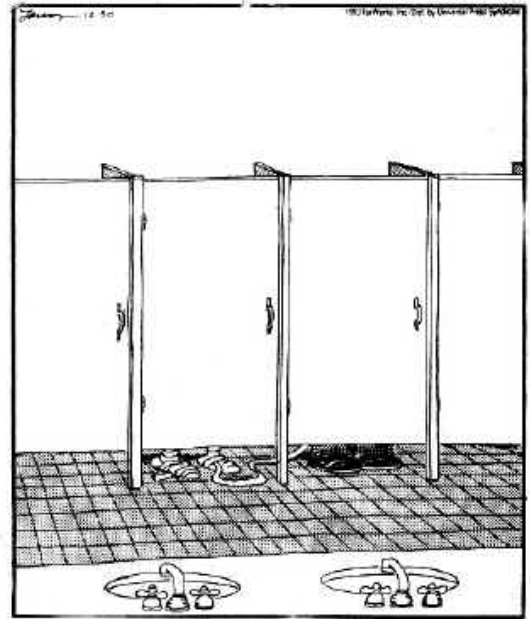
